

WORKSHOP LEADER MARK SHEPARD

Mark Shepard is the CEO of Forest Agriculture Enterprises and runs New Forest Farms, the 140-acre perennial agricultural forest considered to be one of the most ambitious sustainable agricultural projects in the United States.

At New Forest Farm, trees, shrubs, vines, canes, perennial plants and fungi are planted in association with one another to produce food (for humans and animals),



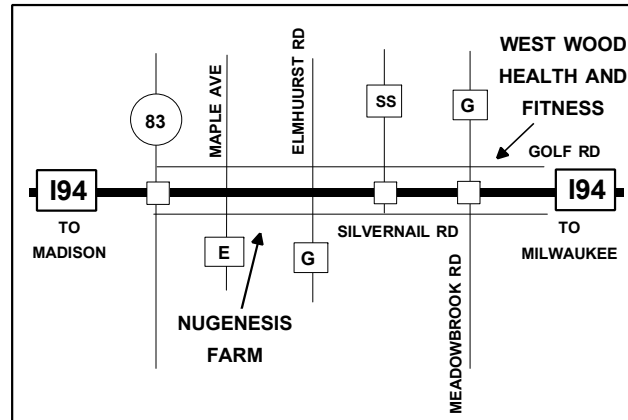
fuel, medicines, and beauty. The farm runs entirely on solar and wind energy and farm equipment is powered with locally grown,

waste vegetable oil—the product of a cooperative business between a local potato chip producer and local farmers.

Mark is trained in both mechanical engineering and ecology, was certified as a Permaculture designer in 1993 and received his Diploma of Permaculture design from Bill Mollison, the founder of the international Permaculture movement.

“Our mission at Forest Agriculture Enterprises is to help people and organizations to do something positive and REAL to change the world. One way to do this is to plant trees. Not just any trees; however, but trees that produce food, medicines, fuels and fiber. And not just trees, but shrubs, vines, canes... in fact, entire ecosystems!”

NuGenesis Farm is a laboratory in the field focused on growing foods with the strongest disease prevention properties, conducting research to support this, improving community health, teaching communities how to grow these foods and making them widely available so individuals can learn how to incorporate them into their daily lives.

WHAT IS PERMACULTURE?

Permaculture is a sustainable design process that emphasizes the relationship and interconnection between all natural things.

This design process creates landscapes that are beautiful, ecologically sound, economically productive, non-toxic and functionally efficient.

Permaculture designs reduce labor by placing individual elements in functional relationship to one another. Materials and energy flows are designed to be a closed-loop. Biological productivity increases over time and human energy is used to increase synergies.



The transfer of natural energy through water, living soil, trees and seeds is used to establish a productive environment that can grow food, build and maintain shelter, use resources wisely, and support life sustainably.

Principles of permaculture design are actively used in urban, suburban and rural environments.
