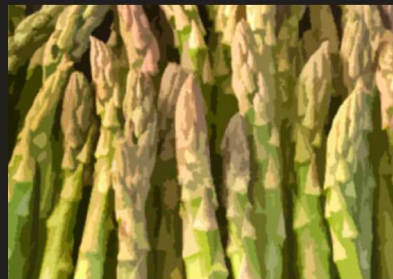
\$40 for youth between the ages of 6 and 12
